At the time, I was reluctant to step into a role so closely connected to my personal grief. I was not yet ready to walk the path my mother had so courageously forged as a palliative care patient herself.

Over the years, however, that journey has brought healing. Experiencing palliative care from the perspective of a family member has given me a deep appreciation of the invaluable role that home-based palliative care plays in providing comfort, dignity and unwavering support to patients and their loved ones during life's final chapter.

The past year has been one of remarkable generosity from our community. Between July 2025 and June 2026, AsPac raised a total of RM721,552 through our fundraising initiatives:

YOUR VOLUNTEER JOURNEY

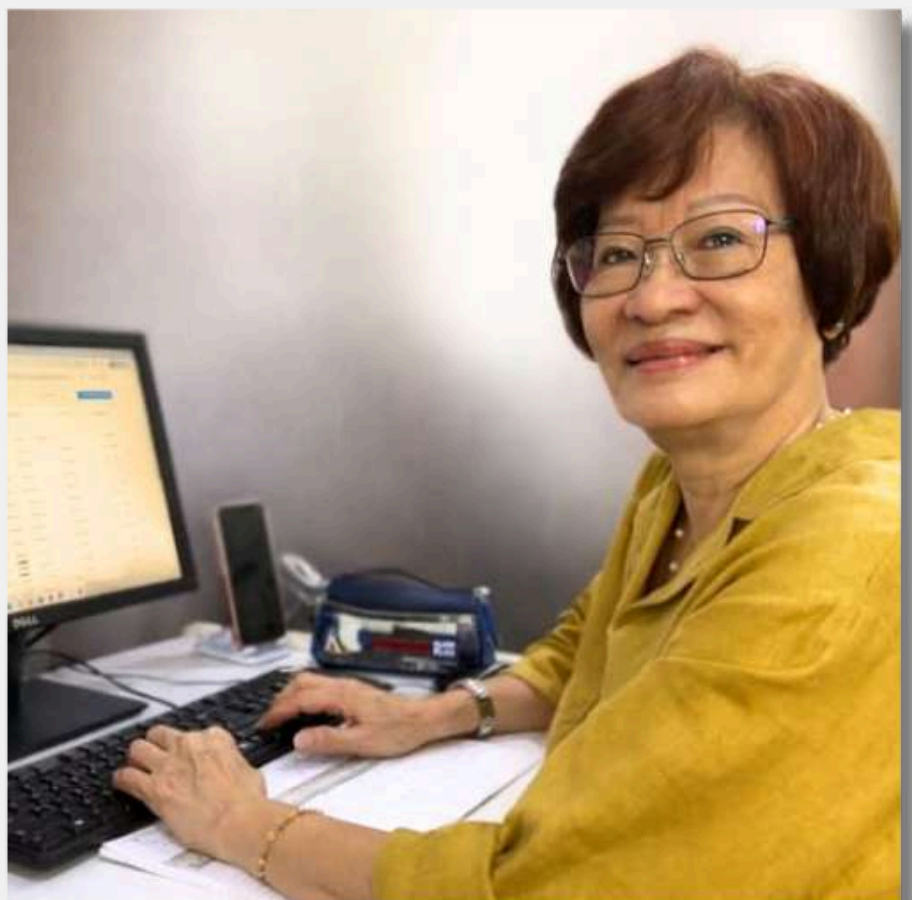

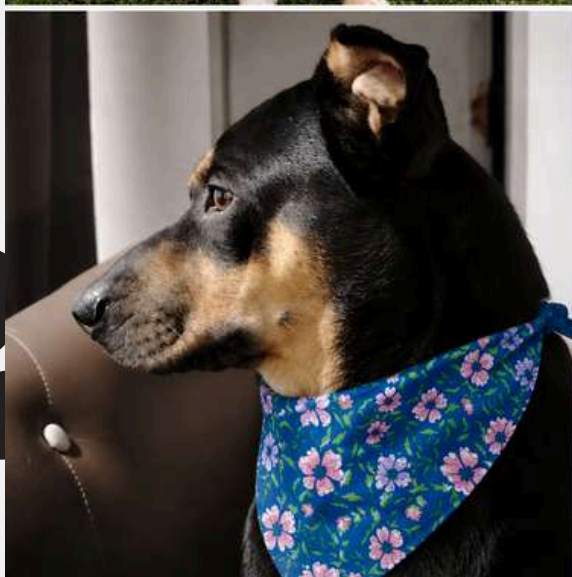

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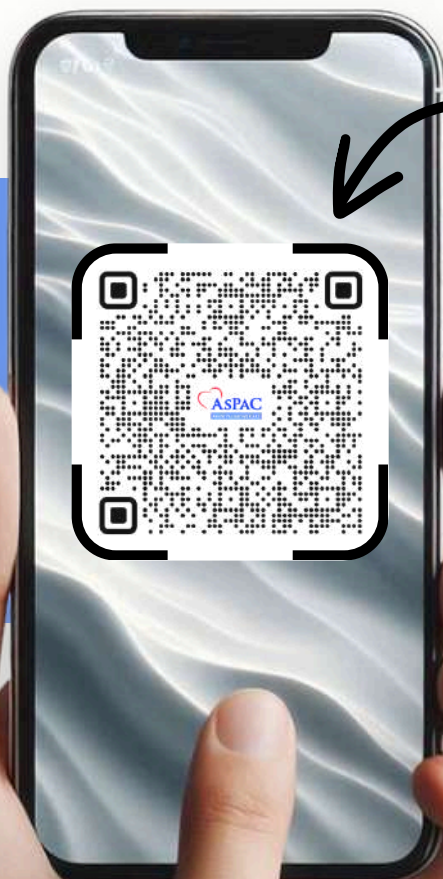
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
